New base for SFS as firm marks 15 years

A COVENTRY company which supports small businesses has marked its 15th anniversary by re-locating to a new office.

Small Firms Services has provided registered office services, company formation advice and virtual offices with specialist services since it was set-up by brothers Steve and Mike Harris.

The eight-strong company has now moved from Copthall House in Station Square due to the Friargate development to its new 2,000 sq ft offices in Sheriffs Orchard, Greyfriars Court in Queen Victoria Road after signing a ten-year lease.
